Rules for contestants

- 1. Must be a resident of Kentucky
- 2. Presently a 6th, 7th or 8th grader
- 3. Must have a $\underline{\mathbf{C}}$ average or better in all course work for the previous year. A school principal and counselor will sign the entry form to verify this.
- 4. The contestants may not have any serious discipline problems at the school for the previous year (those that warrant suspension or expulsion) or serious attendance problems.
- 5. All entrants, parents, or legal guardians must complete and sign an application. Your signature verifies that you will abide by the decisions of the judges.
- 6. The winner will be expected to ride in the parade on the Saturday of the festival and crown next year's Junior Miss Apple Blossom.
- 7. <u>Only</u> the winner will ride in the parade and will be expected to provide their own car and banners/signs for the car. Runner-up and Best Costume will <u>not</u> ride in the parade.
- The <u>daughter</u> of the event chairman, <u>daughter</u> of the Apple Board members, or <u>daughter</u> of the FCCLA advisors sponsoring organization may not enter into competition of any event that requires judges to select a winner. This rule applies to all festival pageants.
- 9. No parent of a contestant may be directly or indirectly involved with the selection of the judges, procurement of prizes, or working behind the scenes with the chairman. Parents may attend practice sessions only and be in the dressing rooms only at the designated times. Parents should be seated during the pageant and not be in or around the contestants dressing area.
- 10. Due to time and space, there will be a limit of $\underline{25}$ contestants.
- 11. Only one person may assist each contestant in the dressing area. Only the contestant will get in free.

Judges/Scoring

- 1. Judges will not be local. The judges will be privately secured and will not receive any information about the contestants until the day of the pageant.
- 2. There will be different judges than previous years.
- 3. Each judge will sign a statement at the conclusion to verify winners. Judges may not be contacted after the conclusion of the pageant.
- 4. A private accounting firm will be retained to tally all scores.
- 5. All scores will be tallied by the accounting firm and held <u>60</u> days after the pageant. At the conclusion of the 60 days the contestant may receive her individual scores by mail. (**Must** submit a self-addressed stamped envelope when application is submitted to receive scores.)
- 6. Students or parents may not inquire about scores at any time before they are returned.
- 7. NO parent may approach, talk to, persuade or have any contact with the judges during the pageant.
